Lack of vaccinations, check-ups, and access to medicines endanger thousands of lives.

- In 2015, 90% of all malaria cases and 92% of malaria deaths were in Sub Saharan Africa.¹³
- Over 95% of tuberculosis cases and deaths are in developing countries.¹⁴
- In 2016, 36.7 million people were infected with HIV worldwide, 2.1 million are children under 15 years of age.¹⁵
- Every 2 minutes, a child under five dies of an AIDS related illness.¹⁵
- There are 1,500 new infections in children every day.¹⁵
