The big challenge: long distances

The rural villages have dirt roads that are impassable during rainy periods, and school is far away for many children. The distance is a risk, especially for female students.



Nelson Mandela Secondary School's needs:



Beds and mattresses for the girls' hostel: The school built a hostel building for female students, so that they do not have to face the challenges of walking long distances to and from school. But they need to equip the building with amenities before the students can move in. Beds and mattresses are on the top of their list.



School kitchen equipment: Nelson Mandela runs an important daily school lunch program for all students. This is supported by Chalice's school farming program, nutrition programs, as well as contributions from the students' parents. The school needs kitchen supplies such as energy efficient stoves, cookware, dishware and utensils.
