Starehe students are academically talented girls who come from vulnerable families in each of Kenya's 47 counties.

- 720 students in high school/boarding school.
- 86 staff members
- Four meals daily supported by a school farm, poultry coop and beehives!



The big challenge: the school relies on generosity

Starehe provides a prestigious education to students from impoverished backgrounds. They do this through the charity and sponsorship of others. Most of the students cannot pay for even simple items. Every budget item must be donated or fundraised.

Starehe Girls' Centre's needs:



Computers: There are not enough computers in the ICT lab to go around. Students who need online access to work don't have enough time.



Water taps: There are not enough hand-washing stations on the school grounds. Girls must wait to wash their hands, wasting time. More stations will improve hand-hygiene and decrease illnesses.



Dining tables and chairs: There are not enough seats or tables for the new girls to sit comfortably during meal times.



Supplementary food supplies: The school provides a variety of nutritious meal four times a day. For the school to continue doing this it needs a constant supply of food, especially as enrollment increases.
