Kawambwa Site- Zambia-SMS Sub Site

Kawambwa SMS subsite is an organization that works with Chalice Canada in bringing hope to the sponsored children who are visually impaired and vulnerable in the community. The site aims to provide quality education, nutrition, health care and trains families on self-management and self-sustainable projects.

1. EDUCATION

Accomplishment

- i. District literary competitions to learners at primary level were conducted and our two children with albinism came first.



- ii. Number of children at university level increased. One child is at Copperbelt University, two have successfully completed their primary teachers' college training and graduated thus waiting deployment.
- iii. Four children completed their grade 12 with good results and most of the children at kindergarten, primary and secondary are doing fine in their studies.

Goal

- Provide extra tuition so that the literacy levels of our sponsored children can be at 85% and above.
- Counselling and advice to the disadvantaged children and closer supervision to avoid them dropping out of school.

2. HEALTH AND HYGIENE

Accomplishment

- i. Workshop to 11 children about knowledge on their health status was done by health personnel.
- ii. Procurement of disinfectants and latrines promoted cleanliness.
- iii. 100 Mosquito nets were distributed to both sponsored and non-sponsored children.

Goal

- Talks on non-communicable diseases to sponsored and non-sponsored children including parents and staff.
- Procure disinfectant and latrines in order to maintain cleanliness.

3. NUTRITION

Accomplishment

- i. Procurement of food staff was successfully done.
- ii. Distribution of food to children in the community.
- iii. Livestock and school garden supplemented the feeding program in the school and orphanage.

Goal

- Procurement of food stuff
- Distribution of food to children in the community.

Accomplishment

- i. Sense of partnership, integrity and belonging has been noticed among community members.
- ii. Participated in local and district activities like women's day, youth day and independence day
