Chalice has partnered with the Bulacan Diocese, through the Bethlehem House of Bread home, since 1999. The home provides foster care for vulnerable children who are unable to live with their families. Parents of sponsored children had little access to education, and so must find low-wage work in areas such as construction, market vending, laundry and collecting scrap or recyclable materials. Bulacan site focuses on the children's educations to give them greater opportunities in the future.





- There are 1210 children sponsored through Bulacan site.
- In the academic year 2019-2020:
- 61 students graduated from primary school,
- 145 students graduated grade 10,
- 99 students graduated from grade 12, and;
- 4 graduated from college or other post-secondary.



- Bulacan site works with 845 parents or guardians organized into 54 family circle groups.
- Collectively, the families spent 60% of their sponsorship funds on nutrition this year.
- They spent a collective total of 7,180,010.29 Philippines pesos on food and nutrition costs.





Community

- Through the Chalice gift catalogue, 5 more family circles began income-generating activities.
- Many families in the community began urban gardens to grow fresh produce to supplement their families' diets.
