



Our Mbiame site oversees a sponsorship program for children and adults, including children with disabilities who are not able to attend school, orphans, and the elderly who have no family support. Our site also works with families to purchase and feed children nutritious meals, and regularly conducts HIV/AIDS testing.



Education

Goals

1. To improve children's comprehension of general and technical education.
2. To advise and encourage our sponsored children to never lose hope during Cameroon's ongoing political crisis.

Achievements

1. This year, many of our sponsored children attended school in Francophone regions as a result of the socio-political predicament affecting our two English speaking regions.
2. Individuals in workshops like tailoring, building, and carpentry also relocated to Francophone regions complete their training.
3. We supported youth activities during a youth camp organized by the diocesan youth chaplain on the theme "Camp of Hope", as most of the participants were our sponsored children.



Health & hygiene

Goals

1. To provide our children and elderly with quality and affordable medical treatment.
2. To provide a clean environment to both to our children and the elderly.

Achievements

1. Many of our sponsored children and families renewed their health cards.
2. Our sponsored children were constantly educated on the importance of cleanliness.
3. We visited our sponsored families to see their living standard as we encouraged them not to lose hope due to the current political situation.



Nutrition

Goals

1. To improve on the nutrition of the malnourished, the vulnerable and some of our sick families.
2. To provide more food baskets for the internally displaced people at the palace and other parts of our community.

Achievements

1. We participated in Chalice's nutrition program and purchased **12** bags of rice, **16** cartons of oil, **20** cartons of sardines and **25** cartons of spaghetti for **80** sponsored families and elders.
2. We reached out to some families that are affected by the crisis at Mbiame palace that is accommodating many internally displaced people who have escaped from their homes because of the socio-political crisis and were starving there. We distributed bags of rice and some oil.



Family

Goals

1. To continue advising our parents and children on avoiding violence from of the ongoing crisis.
2. To improve the future of our children and their families and guardians through more group projects.



Achievements

1. We conducted a follow-up for family circle members on entering group records in the microfinance books and group projects.
2. Direct family funding money has been successfully disbursed to the beneficiaries.
3. Educated parents on parental care that will protect any of our children from falling victim to the ongoing political crisis.
