Our Nandom site assists parents and guardians through the provision of food, clothing, and household items. All sponsored children attend school and receive uniforms, books, book bags, and shoes. We provide regular medical workshops on urgent health issues. Our site places a special emphasis on promoting the value of educating girls.



Education

Goals

1. To encourage sponsored children to pursue post-secondary education.
2. To encourage a bright future for all of our sponsored children.

Achievements

1. Provided **53** desks to Dondometeng daycare, where children had been sitting on the floor during their lessons.
2. **170** solar lamps were provided to students to help them study at home for their final exams.
3. Some sponsored children were taken to Mole National Game Park for a nature study.



Health & hygiene

Goals

1. To provide national health insurance cards to children and parents for easy access to health facilities.
2. To support preventive health education to prevent diseases.

Achievements

1. Food supplements provided ensured that no child reported sick during the year.
2. A non-sponsored child was successfully treated using critical needs funds after being involved in a motor accident.

Nutrition

Goals

1. To provide at least one nutritious daily meal to all school children.
2. To provide local foods and fruits through school gardens to supplement the school feeding program.



Achievements

1. Provided water tanks to **two** school kitchens for safe water storage that will help with the school feeding program.
2. Parents are able to use sponsorship funds to take care of their children's nutritional needs.

Community

Goals

1. To encourage a supportive, caring and connected community.
2. To have a community that respects each other's views for mutual co-existence.

Achievements

1. We achieved a borehole well for the community in collaboration with Nandom District Assembly.
2. We have built a hall with offices and amenities for staff and which will also serve in training and meeting needs of the community.

Family

Goals

1. To have enterprising families playing leadership roles in the community.
2. For families to have basic knowledge in business, taking loans, and creating savings.

Achievements

1. Group meetings are well attended and members are cooperative.
2. Families are taking loans from the credit union.
