Simbang Gabi (Night Mass): A Filipino Christmas tradition

On December 16 every year, many families begin Simbang Gabi: going to dawn Masses for nine days until Christmas Eve. The Masses are 4:00-5:00 am, when the rooster crows. It's a community affair! After Mass, people meet up with friends in the church plaza and buy special rice cakes (Bibingka and Puto Bungbong, pictured) to eat for breakfast.
